TOTTON AND ELING COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION TRUSTEES' ANNUAL REPORT for the year ended 31st March 2021

The year got off to a very slow start with no community activity for the first three months, although our administrators kept themselves busy by keeping in weekly telephone contact with many members of the community, especially the lonely and elderly. They also used the time to reorganise the office and do some timely repairs and repainting of the rooms.

July saw the re-opening of the Town Council's Car Boot Sale. This was a great success. And a Repair Cafe was held in August.

Seated Exercise classes were able to continue through the lockdown months with the instructor being in the Centre leading Zoom sessions for the participants in their homes.

Age Concern Community Lunch services were able to continue but only through takeaways and home deliveries until September when lunches were again served in the Centre. We then started to get busier again with other lettings also. Our first regular lettings were mainly health-related, including Diabetic Eye Screening sessions and Age Concern's Foot Clinic. There were also some new starts with a number of yoga and exercise groups; and the year ended with the opening of our new Baby Bundles service for parents with babies and young families which provides Soft Play sessions within the Centre and reaches out into the community with free clothing and other resources for families in need.

The cancellation of annual events affecting the Centre in 2020 included the summer Totton Carnival and the Lantern Parade in December, but we were able to hold a small Christmas Fayre.

As well as managing the centre our administrators also collaborated with the Town Council and other local organisations in the local Neighbourhood Plan and in the Totton Timebank.

During the year our Totton Men's Shed project reach a significant stage with the building and equipping of the shed which gave us a valuable new resource for supporting the socialisation of our members as best it could within the changing COVID rules.

We are grateful for the financial support received during the year from local government and from other funders who have helped us not only to maintain most of our existing services but also to add some new ones to meet increasing local needs.

Community Centre

Not surprisingly during 2021 Income fell by £14,578 compared with 2020 due to:

- (a) Decrease in number of funds received from Rental and Hire Receipts of £27,700
- (b) Decrease in Other Income of £637 which was offset by £16,651 received from Business Support Grant giving an overall increase in that category of £16,014.
- (c) Decrease in Bank % £3.

During 2021 Expenditure increased by £1,199 compared with 2020. The largest increase in expenses is accounted for by a rise in depreciation charges of £2,200. Building Service Costs and Salary costs fell by £2,879.

There was Capital expenditure of £6,268 on a storage shed.

The result is an excess of expenditure over income for the year of £14,372

The double-entry problems appear to have been successfully resolved. There are no unexplainded differences to report. A big shout out to the team for all their hard work in achieving this milestone.

Men's Shed

Income was £19,263. In addition Capital expenditure of £40,075.

Producing a combined surplus of £4,981 for the year.
