Totton Men's Shed - Repair Disclaimer

I understand that:

- 1. I bring items to be repaired at my own risk. All repairs are free of charge and carried out by unpaid volunteers. (You may donate to the Men's Shed if you wish). Neither the organisers of the Totton Men's Shed nor the repairers can be held responsible if the item cannot be repaired, the repair does not last, or the item is accidentally damaged in the course of the attempted repair.
- 2. Repairers may choose not to attempt to repair my item. This could be for safety or any other reason. Sometimes a professional repair service is needed. If we can, we will suggest a local provider.
- 3. Repairers may take my item apart and not put it back together again. For example, if the item is unsafe or broken beyond repair.
- 4. If batteries, leads, cables, fuses, or any other 'consumables' are needed, I need to provide them. If we have them in stock, you can buy them from the Totton Men's Shed.
- 5. Normally I must stay with the repairer while my repair is being carried out. The repairer may wish to hold on to the item for a while, to make the repair and may suggest a future date for collection.
- 6. Normally I must take my item away with me when I leave, even if it has not been possible to fix it.
- 7. If I have more than one item, it will be looked at if repairers have time, but I will have to go to the back of the gueue if there is one.
- 8. If I have brought children with me, I'm responsible for their
